Responses will be published in the *Laramie Boomerang* on Sunday, August 10. Contact the paper at 742-2176 if they do not have a photo of you on file. The **Voter Guide** will also be at the University of Wyoming and the Albany County Clerk's office for those who vote absentee.

Instructions: Answer the following questions, using 100 words for question #1, and 75 words for each of the other two. A "word" is anything that has a white space on either side of it. Write in sentences, not outline or bullet format. We suggest that you write in the first person ("I have lived and worked in Laramie...") rather than in the third person ("He/She has lived and worked in Laramie..."). Write out numbers under 10 and use numerals for numbers over nine. Do not count your name or party affiliation as part of the word limit. Write "UW" for University of Wyoming and "US" for United States. If your answers are over the limit, they will be cut by removing words from the bottom up. Otherwise, responses will not be edited except to correct misspellings.

Candidates for Wyoming House and Senate

1. Biographical information about you. (100 words)
2. What does Wyoming government do to ensure that the extractive industries pay all the severance/royalties due the state? What changes, if any, would you make? (75 words)

3. Weather, distance, and lack of public transportation make travel in and through Wyoming a challenge. What can the legislature do to improve inter- and intra-state public transportation? (75 words)

Return your responses so that they arrive by the Tuesday, July 8 deadline.

We prefer e-mailed responses so that it is not necessary to retype before submitting to the newspaper, that assures that your exact words will be used. We have supplied 2 emails below, one to cc as a backup. You can also deliver them by hand (after July 4) or send by US mail to the address below by the deadline. Be sure to put your name at the top of your submission whether it is sent by e-mail or written out.
